Dr. Herbert Marks.

We regret to record the death of Dr. Herbert J. Marks, one of the first Vice-Presidents of the Ski Club of Australia. Dr. Marks was a graduate of Jesus College, Cambridge, and of St. George's Hospital, London. He built up an extensive practice in the speciality of ear, nose and throat, at Sydney, was the University lecturer, and Honorary Surgeon at Royal Prince Alfred and Lewisham Hospitals in that speciality.



Dr. Marks, in addition to his medical honors, was a great sportsman. He was a keen rifle shot, and was one time amateur billiard champion of New South Wales, as well as a good fisherman and golfer. He enthusiastically helped the creation of the Ski Club of Australia, and was a foundation member, as well as one of its first Vice-Presidents. He was at Kosciusko for the first Summit race, and contributed largely by his enthusiasm to making it a success.
